<p>* The books that we delivered to Gustavo Carrion School were in support to the english classes that they already hold with their own resources. CHES does not teach English at Gustavo Carrion only at the other 11 schools to a total of 417 students. The ratio of the total of books delivered is approximately 1 book for every two students. We have instructed our teachers to work in pairs, small groups and with several dynamic activities so that learning is not attached to the books. The book is just one resource to support learning not the main tool.</p>			
<p>** Out of the 240 books that we bought, 14 are pending to be delivered. They will be delivered at the beginning of the new school year to the school that shows the biggest increase on its enrollment. The 4 remaining books were delivered to 2 teachers, the coordinator and the intern we had for two months supporting the English program in the elementary schools CHES works.</p>
